2018 Women in Badminton Scholarships Application Criteria

1. 2018 BEC Summer School

Each Member Association can nominate a female coach for a scholarship to participate in the 2018 BEC Summer School from 7th – 14th July 2018, Podcetrtek (SLO). Priority will be given to Member Associations which have not previously received scholarship for the BEC Summer School.

To be eligible, the applicant;

- good spoken and written English
- hasn't taken part in previous BEC Summer School
- has good knowledge of badminton and basic coaching experience
- 2. 2018 BEC Congress

Each Member Association can nominate a female delegate for a scholarship to participate at the 2018 BEC Congress from 13th & 14th April 2018 in Dubrovnik, (CRO).

To be eligible, the applicant;

- cannot be a voting delegate and must be either a staff or board member of the nominating Member Association.
- hasn't taken part in previous BEC Congress.
- 3. 2018 BEC Umpire Course

The goal for this scholarship is to provide support for umpires' education and for them to gain international experience. The exact dates and locations of the courses are: 7^{th} -10th June, Kaunas (LTU) and 4^{th} – 7^{th} October, Sofia (BUL).

To be eligible, the applicant:

- must be a National Graded Umpire
- has international umpiring experience in U17 Junior Circuit and/or Elite Circuit
- have good communication skills in English
- need to be in good health and have a reasonable level of physical fitness
- 4. 2018 BWF Para-Badminton International Tournaments

This scholarship is offered to *first time competing female* para-badminton player. Applicants who fulfill the criteria from 'Priority One' will be chosen first and followed by applicants from 'Priority Two' if there is still availability. Women in Badminton Scholarship Programme

To be eligible, the applicant;

Priority One

- need to be first time competing female para-badminton player from a newly active Member Association which has never taken part in any BWF Para-Badminton International Tournaments
- need to pass the athletes classification process and is awarded the 'Confirmed' status
- need to compete in a BWF Para-Badminton International Tournament in the same year

Priority Two

- need to be first time competing female para-badminton player from a current active Member Association
- need to pass the athletes classification process and is awarded the 'Confirmed' status
- need to compete in a BWF Para-Badminton International Tournament in the same year
- 5. Others
- The scholarship recipient must attend the full duration of the event and participate actively.
- The scholarship of €500 will be paid to the Member Association <u>after</u> the completion of the event together with all the necessary supporting documents not later than one week after the event.
- The supporting documents needed are:
 - A completed participation report
 - Photos of the recipient from the event
- If the application exceeds the available spots, applicants will be ranked accordingly in each group to ensure a fair selection of recipient.
- The selection of the scholarship recipient will depend on Badminton Europe's (BEC) past scholarship recipients and the applicant's eligibility. BEC has the right to accept or decline any applicant.
