

2020 Women in Badminton Scholarships Application Criteria

1. 2020 RSL BEC Summer School – Coach Education Level 2 Course

Each Member Association can nominate a female coach for a scholarship to participate in the 2020 RSL BEC Summer School from 4th – 11th July 2020, Podcetrtek (SLO). Priority will be given to Member Associations which have not previously received scholarship for the BEC Summer School.

To be eligible, the applicant has to fulfil the following;

- is good in spoken and written English
- is an active coach in applicant's respective country
- has minimum BWF Coach Education Level 1 certificate or equivalent or players with national/international badminton experience;

2. 2020 BEC Congress – Members' Forum, Annual Delegates Meeting, Awards Gala Evening

Each Member Association can nominate a female delegate for a scholarship to participate at the 2020 BEC Congress from 3rd & 4th April 2020 in Bucharest, (ROM).

To be eligible, the applicant;

- cannot be a voting delegate and must be either a staff or board member of the nominating Member Association.
- hasn't taken part in previous BEC Congress.

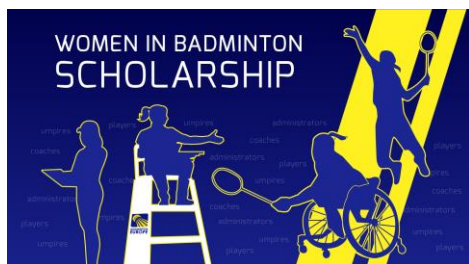
3. 2020 BEC Umpire Course

The goal for this scholarship is to provide support for umpires' education and for them to gain international experience. The exact dates and locations of the courses are:

- 4th March to 8th March 2020, Caldas De Rainha (POR) *or*
- 2nd to 5th April 2020, Dubrovnik (CRO) *or*
- 18th to 22nd November 2020, Glasgow (SCO)

To be eligible, the applicant:

- must be a National Graded Umpire
- has international umpiring experience in U17 Junior Circuit and/or Elite Circuit
- have good communication skills in English



4. 2020 BWF Para badminton International Tournaments

This scholarship is offered to *first time competing female* Para badminton player. Applicants who fulfill the criteria from 'Priority One' will be chosen first and followed by applicants from 'Priority Two' if there is still availability.

To be eligible, the applicant;

Priority One

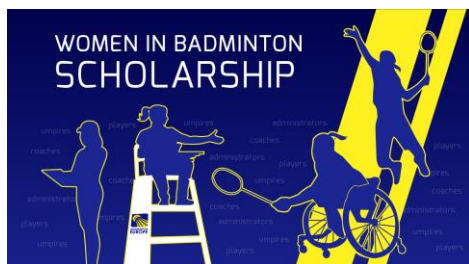
- need to be first time competing female Para badminton player from a **newly active** Member Association which has never taken part in any BWF Para badminton International Tournaments
- need to pass the athletes classification process and is awarded the 'Confirmed' status
- need to compete in a BWF Para badminton International Tournament in the same year

Priority Two

- need to be first time competing female Para badminton player from a current active Member Association
- need to pass the athletes classification process and is awarded the 'Confirmed' status
- need to compete in a BWF Para badminton International Tournament in the same year

5. Others

- The scholarship recipient must attend the full duration of the event and participate actively
- The scholarship of €500 will be paid through the Member Association after the completion of the event, if all the necessary supporting documents have been received **not later than two weeks after the event**
- If the participants pay his/her own expenses, it is responsibility of the Member Association to reimburse the participants
- The supporting documents needed are:
 - A completed participation report
 - High quality photos of the recipient from the event
